

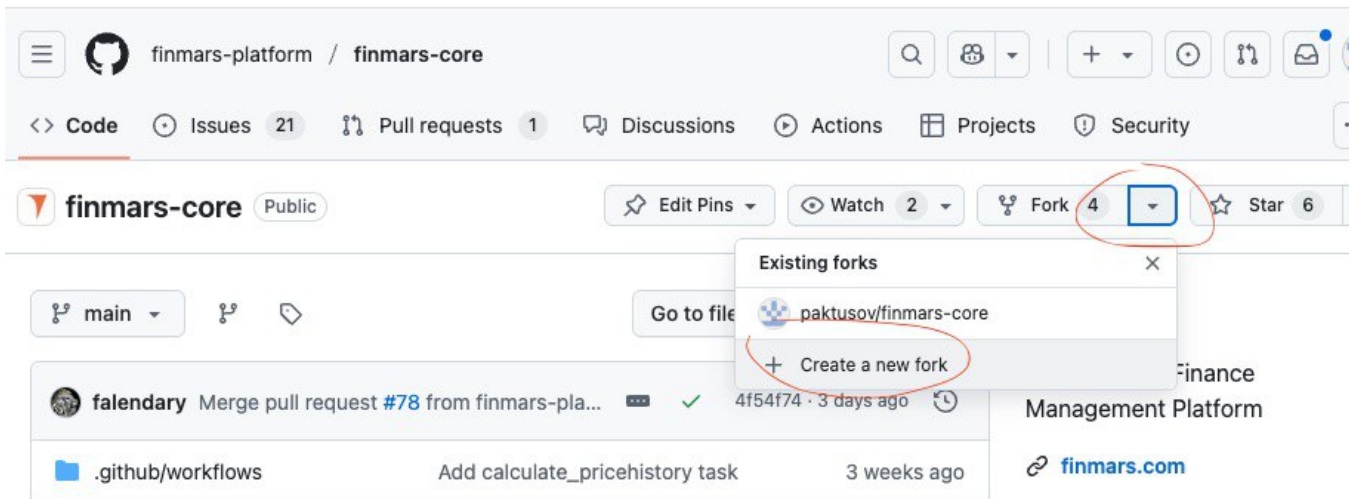

Create Pull Request in repositories

Here is a example of contributing Finmars repositories

1. Create fork



2. Clone this fork

Example:

```
git clone https://github.com/<your-account>/<repo>.git
cd <repo>
```

3. Create new branch

Example:

```
git checkout -b <feat>
```

4. Make changes

5. Fix change

Example:

```
git add .
git commit -m "<commit message>"
```

6. Push changes

Example:

```
git push --set-upstream origin <feat>
```

7. Create Pull request

1. Checkout to <feat> branch in github.com
